#### WHAT IS THE FAMILY SUCCESS CENTER?

The Mayfair/Paradise Center is one of nine Family Success Centers strategically located in designated neighborhoods across Wards 7 and 8. While each center approach is different, all Centers embody core goals to empower communities, integrate services, and connect families and the community to resources to meet immediate and long-term needs.
