We received 19 FOIA requests in this reporting period (Fiscal Year 2007). Due to the volume of some of the requests, assistance with retrieving data was required from our IT staff. In some instances the requests are precursors to litigation. For requests that required additional time to process beyond the 15 days, extensions were requested and agreed upon by the requestor.

The average number of days to process FOIA requests reported may be somewhat skewed as a result of utilizing the mean as opposed to the median. For example, the processing days for the 7 "requests processed in 26 days or more" (including the one denied) range from 36 to 72 days.
