WHAT IS THE GENERATIONS UNIT?

The Generations Unit provides extra support and guidance to pregnant and parenting youth in care so they can achieve the following while balancing the responsibilities of parenthood:

- Complete their education
- Gain work experience
- Master other life skills

The Generations Unit offers additional support in the form of development courses for adolescents and young parents entitled to Generation Next.

Pregnant and parenting youth need extra support and guidance to complete their education, gain work experience and master other life skills while balancing the responsibilities of parenthood. OYE provides services tailored to help pregnant and parenting youth manage their special challenges.

An outreach specialist works with private providers to ensure teen parents on their caseload are linked to community resources for supportive services, including:

- Assistance with obtaining a daycare voucher
- Referrals to the safe sleep program
- Information about accessing WIC
